ORDER

On May 14, 2012, pursuant to the court's order of March 20, 2012, the parties filed a Joint Status Report in the subject matter. The parties' status report gives an overview of outstanding claims and settlement negotiations that are underway in the subject matter. There are approximately 700 remaining plaintiffs in this suit.

The parties continue to discuss the Fair Labor Standards Act exemption status of certain employees in GM-13 positions. In addition, defendant is reviewing information recently provided by plaintiffs regarding their October 13, 2010 settlement proposal concerning plaintiffs who worked for the Office of Personnel Management as background investigators. The parties also report that they are close to a settlement of the claims of approximately sixty plaintiffs transferred to Opa Locka Airport after Hurricane Andrew.

In conclusion, the parties report that they continue to discuss a number of other claims and issues, and request that their next status report be filed on or before July 17, 2012. Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the parties shall

FILE a Joint Status Report, on or before **July 17, 2012**, to apprise the court of the status of the resolution of the claims in the subject matter.
