**ORDER**

On September 28, 2011, pursuant to the court’s orders of August 1, 2011 and September 12, 2011, the parties filed a Joint Status Report (JSR) in the subject matter. The parties’ status report gives an overview of outstanding claims and settlement negotiations that have occurred and/or are underway in the subject matter. There are 715 remaining plaintiffs in this suit.

The parties continue to discuss the FLSA exemption status of certain employees in GM-13 positions. In addition, the government is reviewing supporting information for plaintiffs’ settlement proposal regarding approximately fifty plaintiffs who worked for the Office of Personnel Management as background investigators. Plaintiffs are considering the government’s response to their settlement proposal regarding the claims of approximately sixty plaintiffs transferred to Opa Locka Airport after Hurricane Andrew.

In conclusion, the parties report that they continue to discuss a number of other claims and issues, and request that their next status report be filed on or before November 15, 2011. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the parties

shall **FILE a Joint Status Report**, on or before **November 15, 2011**, to apprise the court of the status of the resolution of the claims in the subject matter.
